Welcome to PATCH



PATCH is the parent teacher association (PTA) for St Mary's Fields Primary School and stands for Parents and Teachers, Carers and Helpers.

A new handbook will be out soon, which will tell you more about who we are, what we do and how we do it. Briefly, however, most of our work is to do with raising funds to help make school life interesting and rewarding for your child by paying for or towards the cost of things that are not covered by other funding.

For example, PATCH has paid towards the cost of maintaining the Key Stage 1 playground equipment, cookery lessons at the Manor House and Year 6 leavers gifts. We also make sure that there is something available for each year group to use towards things like the cost of school trips.
