### Literacy: Reading and Writing



Oral Segmenting – this is when you split a word up into its individual sounds (c-a-t). We call this 'robot talk'. • ee

• igh • ay



Oral blending - this is when you blend the sounds together to say the word (cat). We use a blending arm motion from left to right to help blend the sounds together.

At home practise segmenting words for your child to blend, eg, can you go to b-e-d? (bed) or "drink your m-i-l-k." (milk).

Using our phonics to help us read: Reading Blend and segment known sounds for reading Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter—sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few exception words.

VC words: at, it. CVC words: mum, dog, pin, sat. CVCC words: milk, hump, sand.




