Dear Parents / Carers,

On Friday, 7th March 2025, St Mary's Fields Academy is hosting a Mock Magistrates Trial Competition. On the day we will be joined by pupils from seven other local schools as part of the educational competition. This event for Leicester City Schools has been developed by the Leicestershire and Rutland Magistrates Association – Magistrates in the community educating young people about the dangers of crime.

The event involves educating pupils about knife crime as well as the dangers and myths surrounding it. A presentation on 'knife crime choices and consequences' will be given and then some selected pupils will be given 'parts' and the remaining pupils will form the mock trial court audience. There will also be time for the children to have a question and answer session during the event. Schools will go head to head to perform their roles in the mock trial and they will receive scores for how well they perform. Headteachers of all of the schools have checked the materials for suitability.

Those pupils who have been selected to play a specific part in the Mock Trial (5 Speaking and 3 Non-speaking parts) will act out a pre- rehearsed script around a knife crime incident, where there will be deliberations to determine the outcome of the case. The aim is to educate the children around knife crime as well as an understanding into the youth justice system. Pupils with selected parts will be provided with a script, they will have the chance to practice working through the script in school before the event and they will be able to have the script with them on the day to read out from if necessary.

The roles to play on the day are;

- Prosecution Solicitor
- Legal Advisor
- Witness (x3)
- A PCSO
- Magistrate
- Court Artist
- Court Reporter
