
#### \_iteracy: Writing

#### Using our phonics to help us read:


Continue to apply knowledge of blending and segmenting to reading and spelling simple two-syllable words, captions and simple sentences. How do we read?


We look at the letters, make the sounds and blend the sounds together' OR if it's a tree word 'We see the word and say the word



- Talk about why leaves change colour.






Math's


This unit introduces the mathematical patterns of doubling, halving and odd and even numbers. At this stage, children will explore the patterns and practise using the new vocabulary.




### Music
