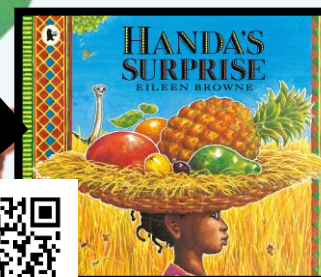
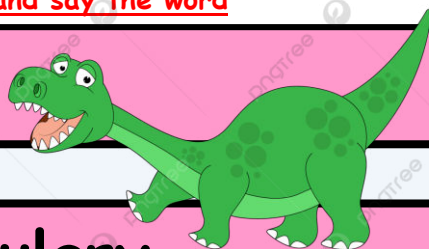
Literacy: Reading

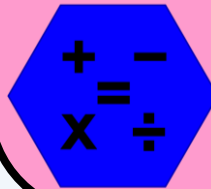
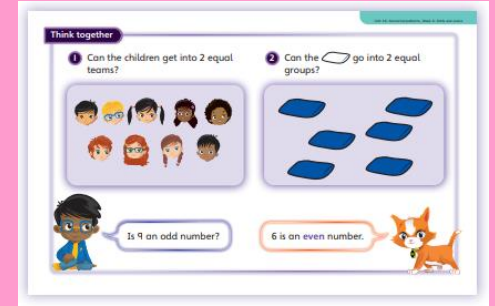
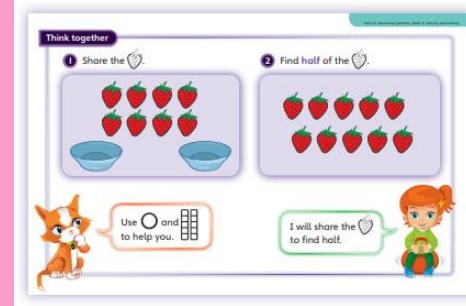
This term we will:

- Talk about why leaves change colour.

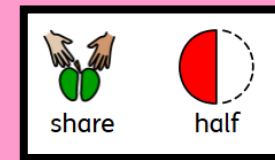


Math's

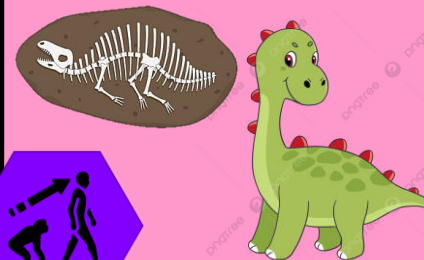
Music
