

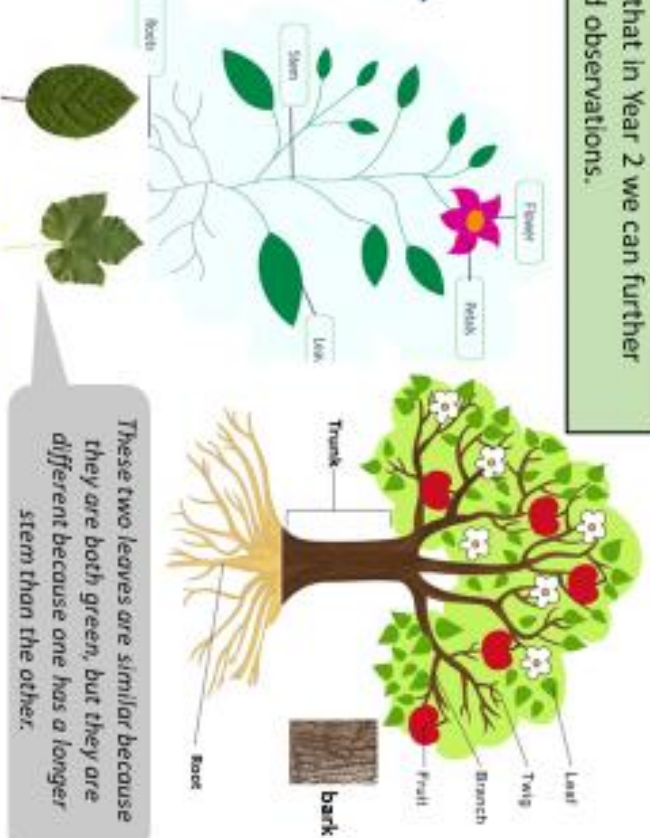
# Year 1- Science- Plants
